GENERAL INFORMATION

The cemetery is owned and maintained by the City of Conway, overseen by the Lakeside Cemetery Committee, and graciously shared as a fundraiser for the Horry County Historical Society on this day. Research of historically documented information will portray accurate information on ten individuals who played an integral role in the early history of Horry County.

TIME ALLOTTED PER TOUR: Docent led tours will last for approximately one hour. In addition, please allow 30 minutes for van transportation to and from the cemetery.

TRANSPORTATION : All transportation to and from Lakeside Cemetery will be provided on a Historical Society van that will depart from and return to, the parking lot in front of Ocean Fish Market, 302 Kingston Street, Conway, SC. No parking will be allowed at Lakeside Cemetery or the surrounding neighborhood.

CLOTHING: Wear comfortable low-heeled walking shoes. Bring a light weight jacket, should the weather be cool.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: Bring an umbrella. The tours will be held come rain or shine.

OPTIONAL ITEMS: Bug spray, bottled water

BRYAN HOUSE ACTIVITIES: In addition to the tours inside the cemetery, visitors are invited to the Bryan House, Headquarters for the Horry County Historical Society, 606 Main Street, Conway, SC for scheduled docent led house tours and outside activities.
