CEMETERY ETIQUETTE REMINDERS



GRAVE SITES:

All graves are hallowed ground and need to be treated with respect. Do your best to not walk over the graves. Common sense leads you to know the basic shape of a grave. Walk in between the headstones and never stand on top of a burial place. Respect monuments and gravestones.

DRIVEWAYS:

Stay on driveways as your tour moves from one designated grave to the next. Uneven driveways may prove difficult for those in wheelchairs or may be handicapped. At all times be aware of where you are walking and always watch your step for your safety.

LIBRARY VOICE:

Please keep your talk to low levels.

HATS OFF:

If a man is wearing a hat, he is asked to show respect by removing it at the gravesites.

STAY WITH THE TOUR GROUP:

Stay with the tour group at all times. While many graves along the tour route may be of interest to you personally, you are asked to return at a later date to explore on your own.

PICKING OF FLOWERS:

Even though Lakeside Cemetery is in a garden setting, you are asked to refrain from picking camellias, azaleas or any other blooming flowers.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES:

All cell phones, iPhones, etc. should be turned to OFF or SILENT throughout the tour.

TRASH RECEPTACLES:

Trash receptacles will be provided at the tour site.
